

Help 2020 CTE Completers Refresh Their Knowledge & Earn Credentials!



Across the country CTE educators are challenged with how to gauge learning gains and losses due to the drastic changes as a result of COVID-19. NOCTI continues to hear from the CTE community regarding the need to help learners to earn credentials, and also to gauge existing knowledge and skills prior to credentialing. Here's how we can help!

Schools planning to provide their 2020 completers with opportunities for credentialing, college credit, and recognition during the summer and early fall can utilize the model below:

Use NOCTI pre-tests to target student knowledge and plan learning activities. To assist with this unprecedented COVID-19 situation we all find ourselves in, NOCTI is making an exception to its pre-test policy to allow for summer/early fall pre-testing, provided there are at least 4 weeks between pre-test diagnostics and post-test administration.

Administer pre-tests in a student's home through remote proctoring, in small proctored settings, or in a larger computer lab depending on your social distancing protocols.

Incorporate free digital study guides into learning plans. Free digital study guides are available with post-test orders and accessible 24/7 on mobile devices as well as desktops and tablets. They allow instructors to follow students' progress and provide a reusable question bank to assess student comprehension.

Administer the NOCTI post-test credentialing assessments to students at the end of their extended learning to allow the opportunity to earn a credential.

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Pre-tests and digital study guides ordered by July 31 will be set to expire on **September 30, 2020**. Post-tests will be set to expire on **June 30, 2021** to align with the already extended expiration date NOCTI applied to all unused tests ordering during spring 2020.
