



**Certified Junior Culinarian
Secondary Culinary Graduate
Certified Junior Pastry Culinarian**



The American Culinary Federation (ACF) offers a certification for graduates of the American Culinary Federation Education Foundation (ACFEF) Secondary Certified programs. Students are able to obtain a certification if they meet certain requirements.

CERTIFIED JUNIOR CULINARIAN REQUIREMENTS:

- Graduate from an ACFEF Secondary Certified program
- Pass the ACF Culinary Arts Certification written and practical assessment. A passing score of 70% or higher is required on the written exam and a score of 75% or higher is required on the practical exam.
- No outside work experience is required for the certification

SECONDARY CULINARY GRADUATE REQUIREMENTS:

- Graduate from an ACFEF Secondary Certified program
- Pass the ACF Culinary Arts Certification written and practical assessment. The minimum cut score to earn the certificate is 70%. The 70% may be achieved on the written test only or as an average of the written and performance test scores.

CERTIFIED JUNIOR PASTRY CULINARIAN

- Graduate from an ACFEF Secondary Certified program
- Pass the ACF Retail Commercial Baking Certification written and practical assessment. A passing score of 70% or higher is required on the written exam and a score of 75% or higher is required on the practical exam.

Online Administration

- Pre-Assessment (written only): \$12.00
- Post-Assessment (written only): \$20.00
- Post-Assessment (written and performance set): \$24.00

Paper/Pencil Administration

- Pre-Assessment (written only): \$23.00
- Post-Assessment (written only): \$30.00
- Post-Assessment (written and performance set): \$34.00

These fees are paid directly to NOCTI. Program coordinators will contact and make arrangements with NOCTI to administer the assessments. The NOCTI contact number is 800-334-6283.

Study Guides

- Package (10 student guide and 1 teacher guide): \$38.00
- Set (5 additional student guides): \$12.00

In the event a candidate fails the written exam, a retest can be requested from NOCTI (additional fee applies) by the Program Coordinator. If the school contract with NOCTI allows, a candidate may apply up to 6 months from their program completion date. Retesting will be done at the discretion of the school's culinary instructor.

CULINARY AWARDS:

- A CJC certificate is available for \$35.
- A Secondary Culinary Graduate certificate is available for \$25.
- If desired, both the CJC and the Graduate certificate are available for \$50.
- A Graduate Patch is available for \$10

PASTRY AWARDS:

- A CJP certificate is available for \$35.
- A Graduate Patch is available for \$10

The assessment results are to be returned with the Award Request Form. The ACFEF encourages schools to recognize this achievement by honoring students at school awards day, graduation, or at culinary program ceremonies. Please allow 3 weeks for processing certifications. Awards are mailed via US mail. If special shipping is requested, the school will be responsible for mailing fees.
