2019 Carl J. Schaefer Memorial Award Recipient Announced

The Carl J. Schaefer Memorial Award was established in 2013 to honor Dr. Carl J. Schaefer. John's industry knowledge and teaching skills have had a positive impact on his students in the classroom, as well as in the community and industry. In addition to teaching pre-engineering, Mr. Wingerter advises the Robotics Team, where students use skills learned to create a combative robot. John also volunteers on the Erie High School disciplinary committee and sets up all media for faculty and student events.
