Create it!

NOCTI's 2025 video contest theme is "CTE Mythbusters!" Students are challenged to debunk common misconceptions about career and technical education (CTE) by showcasing the real benefits, opportunities, and pathways that CTE provides. Use of the NOCTI logo and images of NOCTI products in the video are encouraged. See the application packet for complete rules and requirements.



Submit it!

Eligible videos must be produced during the 2024-25 school year and submitted to NOCTI by January 31, 2025. Review the rules and requirements in this packet to ensure your video meets the contest specifications.



Win it!

Winners will be selected and prizes awarded in February 2025. The winning entry will be the most engaging and memorable video that captures the message of the theme. The prizes are:

First Place – \$500.00 and a class pizza party
Second Place – \$250.00 and a class pizza party
Third Place - \$150.00 and a class pizza party
Honorable Mention(s) - \$100.00 and a class pizza party



INSTRUCTIONS

• Read and follow all the NOCTI Video Contest Rules, Requirements, and Restrictions.

When submitting online:

- Email must be sent from Entrant to nocti@nocti.org
- Email must include:
 - The subject line **must say**: Video Contest Submission-(your video name)
 - Attach a video file or a YouTube link (Max file size: 10MB)
 - o Google Drive and Vimeo files will not be accepted.
 - Attach all required documents in <u>one</u> PDF file.
 (Photos and multiple files will not be accepted)
 - Exception: the spreadsheet for Badges should be a separate file in the Excel format
- Deadline: Entries must be received by email on or before January 31, 2025, 5PM EST.

RULES, REQUIREMENTS, & RESTRICTIONS

Notes:

- The term "Contest" refers to NOCTI's 2025 Video Contest.
- The "Contest Sponsor" is NOCTI, 500 N. Bronson Avenue, Big Rapids, MI 49307 (www.nocti.org).
- The "Entrant" is the teacher who will serve as the designated representative to enter the contest and accept prizes/awards on behalf of the students at a secondary school.
- A "Video" is any Contest entry submitted from September 1, 2024, through January 31, 2025.
- Entering the Contest is free; there are no fees involved.

Requirements for All Videos:

- The Video must be based on the theme: CTE MYTHBUSTERS
- The Video submitted must be student work with minimal assistance from instructors.
- Multiple videos may be submitted by the same secondary school and/or program. However, multiple videos may not be directed/produced by the same student(s) and must have different video participants. Video Titles cannot be identical.
- The Video must not exceed two (2) minutes in length. This time limit <u>does not</u> include the required information slate at the beginning of the Video (see next bullet).
- Information Slate A 5-second full screen slate (title screen) must appear at the beginning of the Contest Video and must include ONLY the following information: (Please use white letters on a black background to make slate easily readable.)
 - Video Title
 Total running time
- Entrant must have permission of <u>all</u> persons- <u>both speaking and appearing-</u> in the Video. This
 includes anyone's face that can be recognized in the video. Entrant **must** provide all Talent
 Release Forms to the Contest Sponsor along with Entry Form and Video.
- The Entry Form and all Talent Release Forms must be scanned and sent in one (1) PDF file.
 - **a.** Photos of the documents or individual pages will <u>not</u> be accepted.
 - **b.** Google doc files or anything that requires permission to view will <u>not</u> be accepted.
- The Video must be created specifically for the NOCTI Contest and cannot have been previously submitted for another promotion or contest of any kind or previously displayed through any other means.
- Once Entrant's Video has been submitted, the entry is final and may not be modified or edited and no submissions will be returned.

Video Content Restrictions:



- The Video must not contain material that violates or infringes another's rights, including but not limited to privacy, publicity, or intellectual property rights or that constitutes copyright infringement;
- The Video must not disparage the Contest Sponsor or any other person or party affiliated with the promotion and administration of this Contest;
- The Video must not contain brand names or trademarks (ie. logos on clothing, computers, camera equipment, food, automobiles, etc.) other than those of the Contest Sponsor, which Entrant has a limited license to use for the sole purpose of creating a Video for this Contest. There are no restrictions on using images of NOCTI supplemental products (e.g., Study Guides and Assessment Blueprints), however, any images/recordings of the actual test and/or test administration will result in immediate disqualification and a potential security breach.
- The Video must not contain any copyrighted music, footage, images, or artwork;
- The Video must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, obscene, hateful, torturous, defamatory, slanderous, or libelous;
- The Video must not contain material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred, or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, or age; and
- The Video must not contain material that is unlawful, in violation of or contrary to the laws or regulations in any jurisdiction where the Video is created.

Technical Requirements:

- Send a link or the video file through email: the file maximum is 10MB.
- The Video must play through YouTube. Please make the video file "unlisted" until the contest
 results are posted. Should the entrant's video earn a first, second, third, or honorable mention
 prize, all announcements regarding the winning Video by the Entrants, the program, or the
 school must be withheld until the Contest Sponsor makes the official winner announcement in
 March.
 - Winners will be asked to send their video file, if it has not already been sent.

Disqualifications:

- Video submissions emailed after January 31, 2025 will be disqualified.
- Videos shorter than one minute or longer than two minutes will be disqualified.
- Videos violating any of the restrictions or not meeting the requirements listed above in this document will be disqualified.
- Videos missing the required Talent Release forms will be disqualified.
- Videos submitted from post-secondary (college) students will be disqualified.
- Schools located outside of the United States are not eligible.
- Disqualification is at the Sponsor's sole discretion.



JUDGING

Videos will be judged on the following criteria:

- 50% Message and appropriateness to theme
- 20% Creativity
- 20% Originality
- 10% Production Quality

Winner Selection:

- All Videos will be pre-screened, prior to judging, to verify compliance of all contest rules.
- A panel of judges selected by NOCTI from the CTE/NOCTI community will choose the winning Videos based on the judging criteria and compliance with all contest rules.
- The decision of the judges is final.
- Winners will be notified by phone and/or email in February 2025.
- The entrant/school will have a shared ownership of the winning Videos. The winning Videos may appear on NOCTI's website and/or may be promoted through other media outlets.
- Should it be determined that there are insufficient entries worthy of being selected as a finalist, NOCTI reserves the right to select fewer than the stated number of winners in any category.
- In the event the Video Contest has been impaired or corrupted for any reason and as a result
 cannot be offered or completed as planned, NOCTI reserves the right in its sole discretion, to
 cancel or terminate the contest.

BADGES

Badges are awarded to all students involved with a Video that places in the Contest. Please fill in the Badge template spreadsheet and return it with the video link and entry forms. The number of students on the list should match the number of Talent Release Forms being submitted. An email address is required for the student to receive the badge. If email addresses cannot be shared with NOCTI, the student(s) will simply not receive the badge.
